





# LMS Usage 2018 vs. 2020







## **Updated Migration Timeline**



Teaching on Canvas begins Fall 2020

Teaching on Canvas begins Spring 2021

Blackboard (All RU-N courses available on Canvas for Spring 2021. Teaching to start no later than Summer 2021)



# Migration Progress Report (Fall 2020)

- Blackboard migrations complete. (5000+ courses)
- SAS Phase 1 migrations complete. (1100+ courses)
- Additional migrations complete for:
  - MGSA, SOE, SMLR, SEBS, EMSOP, and GSAPP.
- Over 60% of courses were on Canvas in Fall 2020.
- Adding Fall 2020 migrations, over 80% of all Rutgers courses are on Canvas in Spring 2021 (to be confirmed after term).
- Canvas student support now under OIT HD.



# Migration Progress Report (Spring 2021)

- SAS Phase 2 now underway (1770 courses).
- GSE (233 courses) and SSW (archive only) underway.
- Law School-N (555 courses).\*Requested 3-year lookback.
- Canvas support for faculty to transition to OIT beginning in Fall 2021.
- Project sites planning has begun. We are looking for SC members to join the working group.
